European Privacy Seal EuroPriSe for SAP TDMS Product

Europe's largest software company, SAP AG based in Walldorf, Baden-Württemberg, receives the European Privacy Seal EuroPriSe for its software Test Data Migration Server (TDMS) version 4.0 and thus reveals exemplary data protection by "privacy by design" for this tool.

TDMS is a software extension for SAP systems which allows supplying data for development, testing, quality assurance and training. The use of personal data outside of the productive systems must meet specific data protection requirements. Using TDMS helps to reduce the data to a minimum. Additionally, the data may be distorted (scrambled), without losing its consistency. Thereby personal data may be distorted by deletions or partial modifications of the data values to such an extent that the reference to individuals is completely prevented (anonymous) or is at least difficult (pseudonymous). TDMS provides a number of predefined scrambling rules to this effect. In addition, temporary data, created in the production system by transferring the data, are deleted immediately after the data transfer.

Since TDMS is a software product, it remains the responsibility of the user to ensure that the results of the selected scrambling rules comply with the legal requirements in each case. For this purpose TDMS helps the user by providing exemplary transparent product and user information.

The EuroPriSe certification confirms that TDMS software facilitates its use in compliance with European data protection regulations.

TDMS is exemplary in data protection by providing the possibility of data minimization and data economy by providing efficient ways to reduce and distort data and by delivering transparent product and user information.
